While there is no charitable deduction, the amount does not count as regular income and is not taxed, and therefore it functions the same as a deduction and satisfies the required minimum distribution of the IRA. 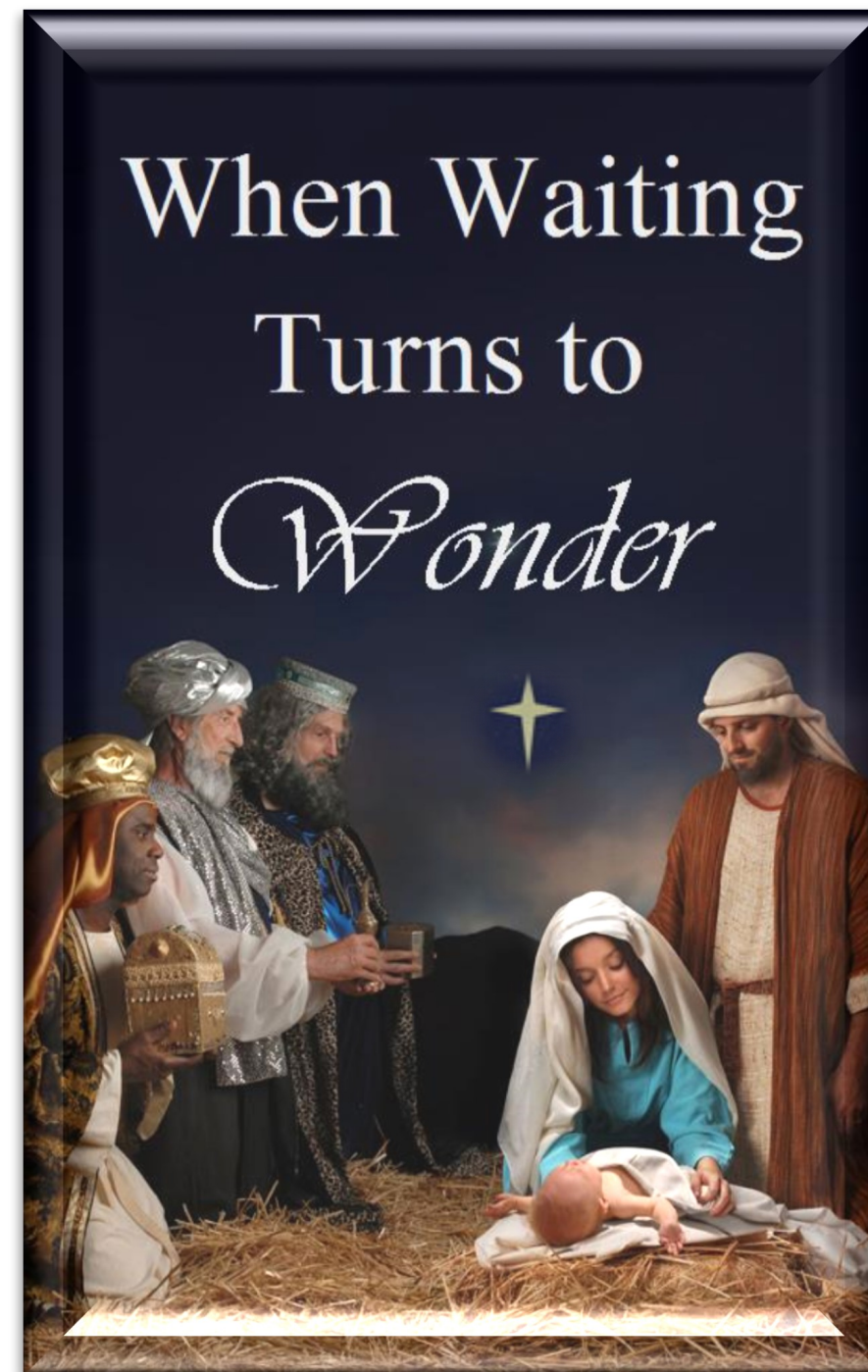
